



Intralogistics Revolution Live – MODERNLOG Trade Fair Behind Us

From June 3–5, 2025, another edition of the MODERNLOG Trade Fair for Logistics, Warehousing, and Transport took place—Poland's most important event for the logistics industry. This year's edition reaffirmed its status as the leading platform for dialogue, inspiration, and experience exchange in the Industry 4.0 sector.

MODERNLOG 2025 brought together market leaders, representatives of top companies, innovators, and experts who collectively discussed the challenges and trends shaping the future of logistics. The event was officially inaugurated by Filip Bittner, Vice President of the MTP Group Management Board, who emphasized the trade fair's role as a hub for collaboration and the presentation of cutting-edge technological solutions. The opening ceremony was accompanied by the prestigious Gold Medal and Acanthus Aureus awards for outstanding products and exhibition stands.

Innovation and Technology in the Spotlight

More than 100 exhibitors showcased their solutions in the MODERNLOG exhibition space—from global tech leaders to Polish companies developing modern tools for logistics and intralogistics. Among the highlights were autonomous mobile robots (AMRs), automated racking systems, intelligent conveyors, and comprehensive WMS (Warehouse Management Systems). Especially noteworthy were integrated technologies that enable real-time process control and monitoring.

In4Log Zone – Automation in Action

As in previous years, the special In4Log Zone was a major attraction—an interactive area where visitors could witness the full order fulfillment process in a modern, automated warehouse. Co-organized by the MTP Group and Medialog, the zone featured an integrated ISL warehouse system, AMR robots, LEAN-LIFT vertical lift modules, CAPTRON's Pick-by-Light system, and advanced packing and securing stations. High safety standards were ensured by Anter System's protective barriers equipped with anti-collision sensors.

"Logistics for E-commerce powered by Allegro" Conference

A key part of this year's edition was the "Logistics for E-commerce powered by Allegro" conference, which brought together managers and professionals from the e-commerce sector. Discussions focused on major challenges in online logistics—from warehouse automation and last-mile delivery optimization to sustainability and efficient return management. Speakers from leading e-commerce companies shared concrete implementations and practical solutions driving the growth of e-commerce in Poland and across Europe.

Start-up Zone and IDEA Startup Challenge

On the third day, attention turned to the Partner Stage and the Start-up Zone powered by Smart Warehouse. Emerging companies presented innovations in automation, artificial intelligence, data management, and sustainable logistics. As part of the IDEA Startup Challenge 2025, an expert jury selected the most promising project—DEPOTRACER, which offers an innovative 3D system for autonomous management of container yard operations, was named the winner.

Facts and Figures

Across the entire trade fair block—which included MODERNLOG, ITM Industry Europe, Subcontracting, and the European Science Fair—14,673 professional visitors from Poland and abroad attended.

MODERNLOG 2025 once again proved to be a place where practical solutions for the logistics and warehousing industries are born, and the conversations held at the stands translate into real implementations in companies.

MODERNLOG has reaffirmed its status as the key event for the logistics sector in Poland. Organizers are already inviting participants to the next edition of the MODERNLOG Trade Fair for Logistics, Warehousing, and Transport, which will take place from May 26–28, 2026.
